Dear valued customer,

Our resin suppliers have a previously announced increase nominated for March 1st. Recent geopolitical events have led oil to spike in pricing and certain grades remain in short supply.

In addition, Epsilon Plastics continues to experience a significant escalation in costs and shortages in non-resin supplies like labor, packaging, freight, pallets, additives, solvents, energy etc. Epsilon has done everything possible to offset these other cost increases with production efficiencies, but it is impossible to absorb these costs given the magnitude of inflation we are experiencing. The increase below considers these non-resin costs that Epsilon Plastics continues to absorb.

In response to the March resin increase and other non-resin cost inflations, Epsilon Plastics will implement an increase of 8% effective with all new orders placed on or after March 28th, 2022.

All orders must call for immediate delivery. Based on current lead times and resin availability, Epsilon Plastics can only accept a limited number of new orders. Epsilon Plastics reserves the right to accept or decline all orders for any reason.
